Show Fees: \$10 per event class entered. AOA and 4H membership not required.

Stall Fees: \$30 (8ftx8ft). This option is for exhibitors opting to arrive on Friday and stay overnight or stay through Sunday. These stalls will be assigned on the basis of availability. There will be NO stall fee if exhibitor just arrives for the day to participate. An area will be specifically designated for day-trippers.

Registration Deadline: Entries, with full payment, must be postmarked by May 23, 2019. The registration form must be signed and dated or it will be returned.

Judge: TBD

Location: Arena 4 (Please review the arrival map on the following page to familiarize yourself with load-in location)

Show Time: 9 a.m. Saturday, June 8, 2019 until show completion.

Exhibitor's Meeting: There will be an exhibitor's meeting with the judge from 8:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. in the alpaca arena.

Check In: Saturday, June 8, 2019, 6:30am-8:00am. Please provide email address on registration - you will be emailed a map to guide you to the day-tripper check-in area.

Exhibitors also have the option to arrive on Friday June 7, 2019 from noon to 6pm at Barn W. Friday arrivals require payment of stall fees and all alpacas should be kept in trailers until vet check is completed before the animals are unloaded at Barn W.

Release: Exhibitors and alpacas will be released upon completion of the show on Saturday, June 9, 2018. NO EARLY RELEASES WILL BE ALLOWED prior to the end of the Performance show.

Premiums: First through third place: \$20, \$10, \$5, for junior through open classes. In classes with less than three exhibitors, only first place premiums will be paid.

Ribbons: First through third place. Overall Grand and Reserve for youth classes. Grand and Reserve determined using points accumulated according to the AOA Performance Show point system.

Age Group Classifications: All ages are determined as of January 1, 2019. Youth under the age of 8 years on June 8, 2019 may show only in sub-junior classes.

Open	19 years old and older

Showmanship Event: The showmanship class is a demonstration of an exhibitor's skill in following directions and style in presenting the animal to a judge for evaluation. The animal used in the presentation is not judged. The handler's attire should be neat, clean and appropriate for all of the classes.

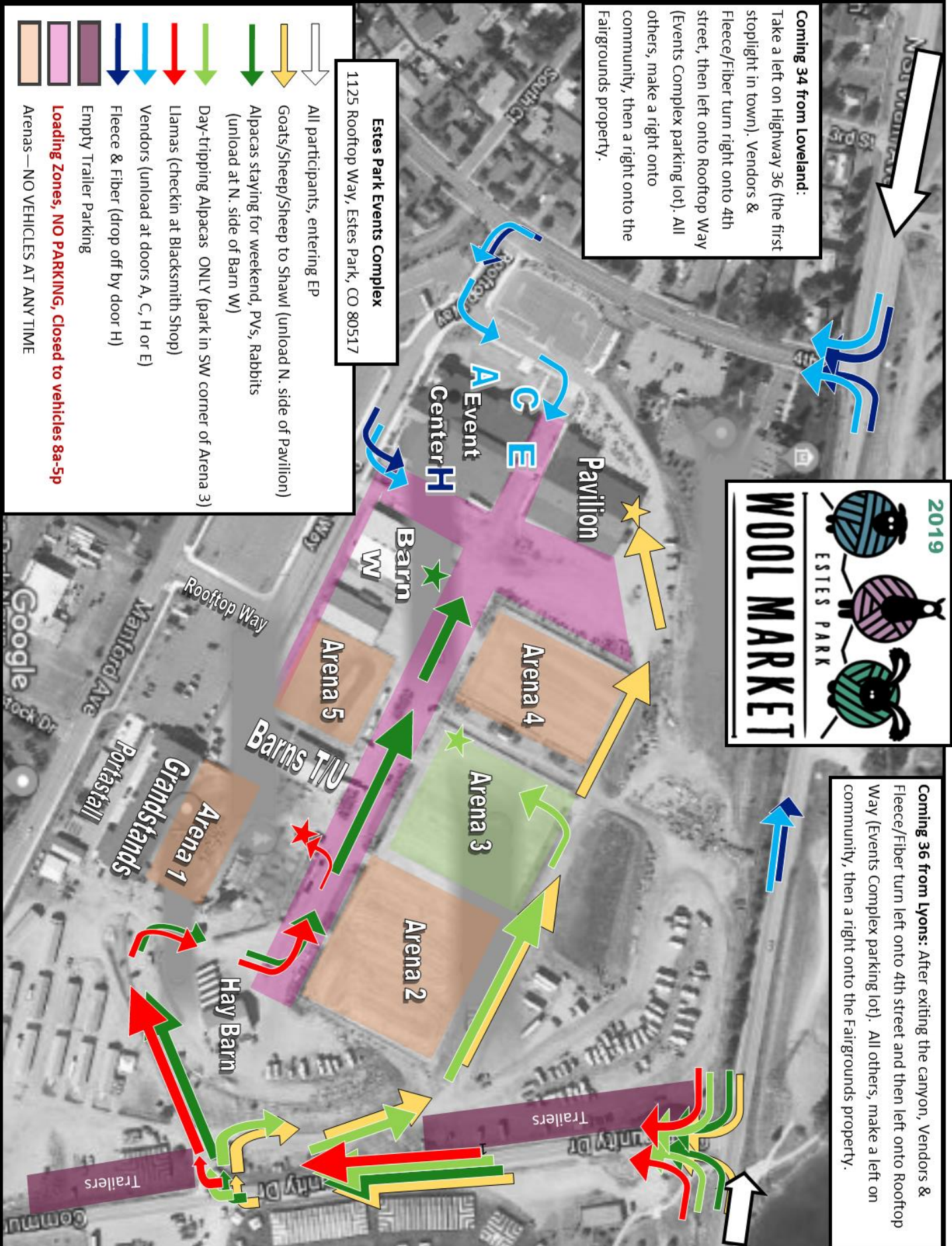

Coming 36 from Lyons: After exiting the canyon, Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn left onto 4th street and then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a left on community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.

Coming 34 from Loveland: Take a left on Highway 36 (the first stoplight in town). Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn right onto 4th street, then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a right onto community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.
