Alpaca Educational Event:

The weekend alpaca event is designed to educate the public regarding agricultural opportunities provided in the alpaca industry. Alpacas will be on exhibit and their owners available to provide detailed breed, husbandry/care, fiber, sustainability, industry, resource, and phenotype information, as well as answer questions of the public about alpacas and camelids in general.

Alpaca fiber-related demonstrations will occur periodically (schedule pending) and other fiber arts may well be found working at their alpaca exhibit/display area anytime throughout the day! All activities occurring in Barn W are free and open to the public.

Registrations Due

The registration deadline is May 23, 2019. *Registration can be mailed or paid by phone and the entry form faxed or emailed.*

Check-In

Friday, June 7th from noon to 6 p.m. All animals should be kept in trailers as the vet check will be done before the animals are unloaded.

4 p.m. on Sunday, June 9th – no early release.

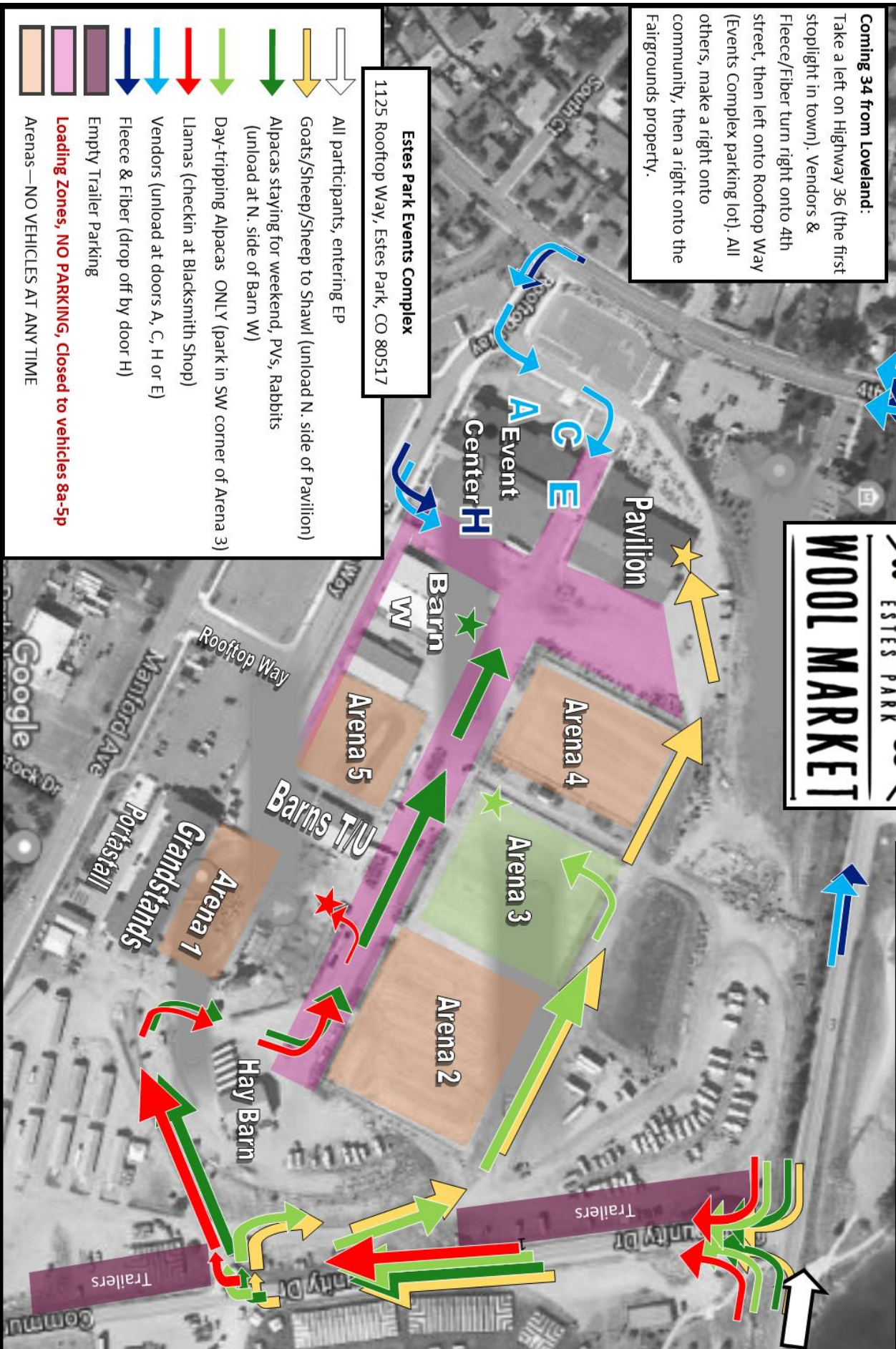
Notes:

- Farm displays are not allowed in the aisles.
- Stalls are assigned in the order they are received.
- Registration forms must be signed and dated or they will be returned to the applicant.
- Exhibitors must supply bedding for animal stalls.



Coming 36 from Lyons: After exiting the canyon, Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn left onto 4th street and then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a left on community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.

Coming 34 from Loveland: Take a left on Highway 36 (the first stoplight in town). Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn right onto 4th street, then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a right onto community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.

- Llamas (checkin at Blacksmith Shop)
- Vendors (unload at doors A, C, H or E)
- Fleece & Fiber (drop off by door H)
- Empty Trailer Parking
- Loading Zones, NO PARKING, Closed to vehicles 8a-5p
- Arenas — NO VEHICLES AT ANY TIME
