## **Fees:**

- \$4.00 to enter the Angora Rabbit Breed Show
- \$1.00 to enter the ARBA Wool Show (animal must be entered in the Breed Show to compete in this class)
- \$1.00 to enter Mixed Breed Wool Show (for all animals that are cross-bred for wool purposes or have disqualifications for Breed Show. Animals do not need to be entered in the Breed Show to compete in this class).
- \$20 exhibit/sales fee to sell rabbits that are not entered in the breed shows

Best of Breed will be selected from the class winners of each breed.

Best in Show will be selected from the Best of Breed winners.

- ARBA Angora Wool Show: All animals entered in these classes must be entered in the breed classes. ARBA wool classes include: Colored Wool; White Wool.
- There will also be a Mixed Breed Wool Class for those animals that are unable to compete in the breed class. Mixed Breed Wool Class animals do not have to be entered in a breed class.
- Ribbons will be awarded for all Best of Breeds and Best Opposite of Breeds; Best Colored Wool and Best White Wool in both the ARBA Wool Show and the Mixed-Breed Wool Show. Rosettes will be awarded for Best in Show and Reserve in Show. This is a premium show.
- Once again, we will be having a fun contest for products made with Angora Rabbit fiber. Entries will be accepted Sunday, same day as the rabbit show, day of show entry encouraged. Entry fee will be \$1.00 per item. Each item should be a minimum of 10% Angora Rabbit fiber. Show off what you have made with your angora. Skeins, knitted/crocheted items, felted items, woven items, whatever you make; we want to show it off.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

1. All rabbits must have a legible tattoo in the left ear.
2. All rabbits must be housed in carriers. Coops or cages will not be provided. Rabbits will remain in Barn W from check in until release. **Animals must arrive between noon Friday, June 7 and 9:00 am Saturday, June 8. Animals will be released at 4pm Sunday, June 9. Exhibitors leaving early will forfeit entries, placements and premiums.**
3. The minimum age of all rabbits will be eight weeks.
4. Pregnant does will not be allowed.

5. Rabbits must be of breeding or wool-production quality. No non-fiber pet sales will be permitted. All exhibitors will be responsible for the sale of their own rabbits.

6. Rabbits must be groomed and free of mats prior to check-in. Minimum coat length is two inches (2). Rabbits exhibiting signs of undue stress, illness or obvious health defects as determined by a veterinary professional will not be allowed.

7. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and feeding of their own rabbits. The Estes Park Wool Market and the Estes Park Events Complex assume no liability for the animals.

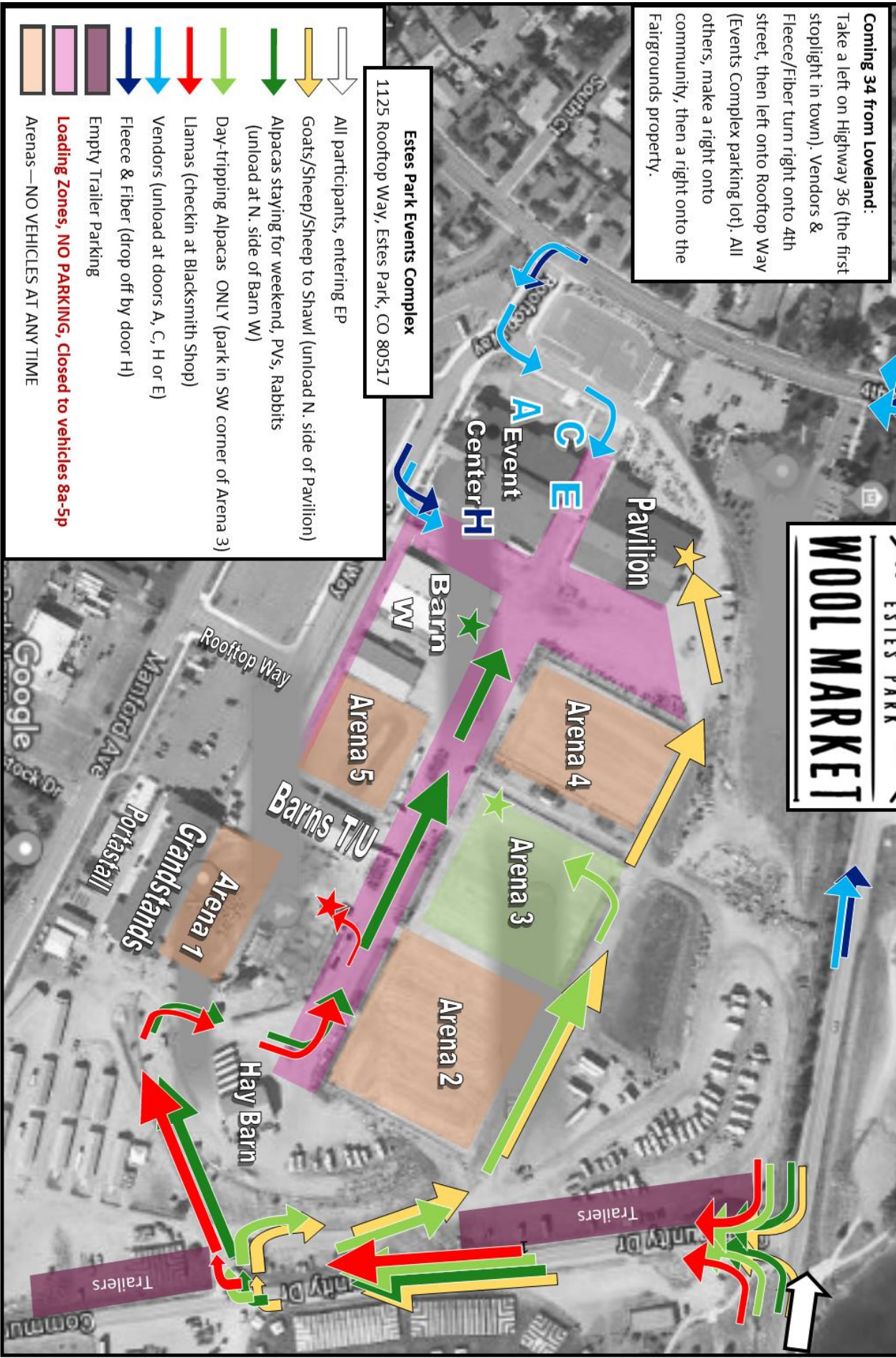
8. All rabbits must pass inspection at check-in for communicable disease.



**Coming 34 from Loveland:**  
 Take a left on Highway 36 (the first stoplight in town). Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn right onto 4th street, then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a right onto community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.



**Coming 36 from Lyons:** After exiting the canyon, Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn left onto 4th street and then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a left on community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.
