Saturday, June 8 and Sunday, June 9, after judging is complete. Fleeces may be withdrawn from the show prior to judging by the producer with no refund on entry fee. Fleeces must be picked up by 3:00 p.m. Sunday, June 9.

Show Rules:

This show is for premium quality fleeces intended for hand spinning use. Fleeces must be shorn/combed within the last 12 months and represent 12 months of growth or less. Yearling fleeces will be allowed 16 months growth.

Definition of color: "white is white," everything else is "Colored".

Fleeces may be delivered or shipped prepaid any time after May 23, 2019 and will be stored at no charge to exhibitors. If you would like to ship your fleeces via UPS or another carrier, please send them to:

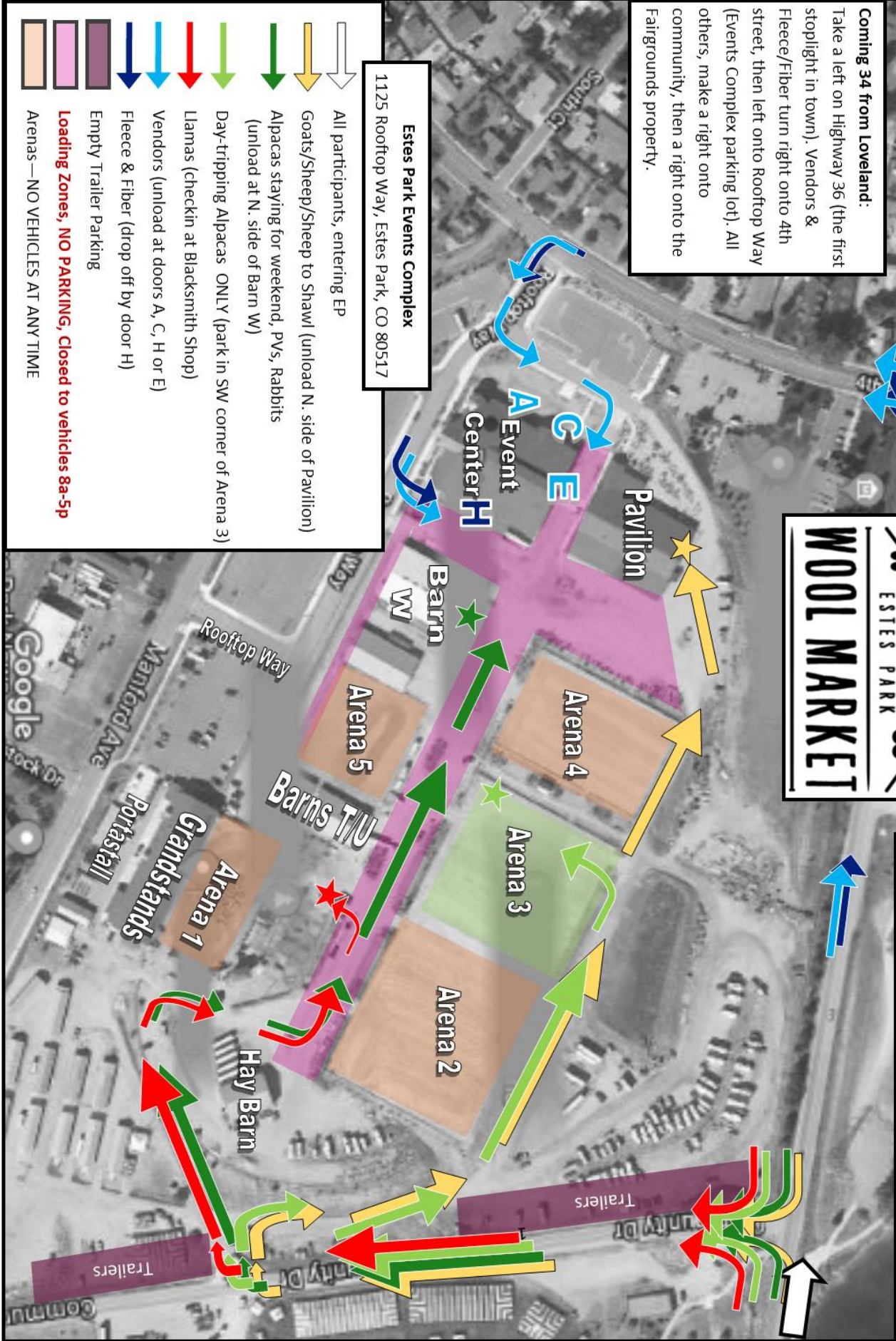

Coming 36 from Lyons: After exiting the canyon, Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn left onto 4th street and then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a left on community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.

Coming 34 from Loveland: Take a left on Highway 36 (the first stoplight in town). Vendors & Fleece/Fiber turn right onto 4th street, then left onto Rooftop Way (Events Complex parking lot). All others, make a right onto community, then a right onto the Fairgrounds property.
